Programme Overview

Water is one of the essential resources for sustaining life and economic activities. This essential source (particularly potable water) is in short supply in urban India and the situation is worsening with every passing day. A total of 756 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in India are identified as water stressed by Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India in 2019. To add to this grave problem, less than 35% of wastewater generated is treated in the urban areas and the rest is disposed off directly into the water bodies further shrinking fresh water sources and leading to severe environmental pollution.

On the other hand, less than 1% of wastewater is reused in urban areas as per the environmental standards set by Government of India. The status quo is due to the lack of awareness about importance of reuse of treated wastewater, weak enforcement of existing regulations, inadequate capacities among city government functionaries, myths prevailing among people at large about reuse of treated wastewater, difficulties in finding the market for treated wastewater and other related factors. This is leading to wastage of a valuable resource which, if utilised appropriately can reduce the burden on fresh water sources, limit pollution load on water bodies, increase water available for drinking purposes as fresh water is being used for certain activities in households and industries for which a lower quality of water is suitable.

Some cities and private firms in India and other countries have successfully proved that treated wastewater can be a great alternative source to fresh water source. Treated wastewater reuse can help service delivery agencies to supplement it with fresh water and eventually act as an effective cost saving business decision and earn them additional revenue in the form of proceeds from sale of treated wastewater. Without reusing treated wastewater, universal access to adequate and safe piped water supply in urban areas cannot be achieved by service providers especially due to looming water scarcity faced by ULBs.

In this context, the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI), India is organising a three-day training programme on 'Wastewater Reuse and Recycling in Urban India' targeting practitioners from Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), Government and non-governmental agencies.

Objectives

To enhance knowledge and skills of practitioners to plan and implement wastewater recycling and reuse program.

At the end of the programme, the participants will:

- I. understand the need and urgency for mainstreaming wastewater reuse and recycling in the urban policy and practice.
- II. gain knowledge on policy and regulatory environment with respect to reuse and recycling of wastewater.
- III. learn strategies to plan for wastewater reuse and recycling at centralized and decentralized levels including technology options.
- IV. understand various Public Private Partnerships (PPP) models that can be adopted for wastewater reuse and recycling.
- V. develop action plan for adoption of wastewater reuse and recycling at city-wide level.

Pedagogy

The training programme will comprise of classroom sessions, case analysis through individual / group work, interaction with practitioners and learning visits.

Resource Persons

The sessions will be delivered by experienced professionals from city governments, established technology providers and start ups and urban governance experts having hands on experience on the related subjects.

Participant Profile

The programme is recommended for city and state government officials responsible for water supply, wastewater management, urban planning, water resource planning, water body protection and other related aspects in the urban areas. The programme is also recommended for consultants, financial institutions and non-government agencies interested in this subject.

Venue

The programme is fully residential and the participants will be accommodated in air conditioned single occupancy rooms. The College does not provide accommodation for the family. College will arrange transport between airport / railway station and venue. The College is WiFi enabled in a comprehensive way.

Duration

The programme duration is from April 15 - 17, 2020. The participants are expected to arrive a day before commencement and may leave after the conclusion of the programme.

Programme Fee

Residential Fee: Rs. 39,000/- (US \$720 for foreigners) plus GST as applicable, presently 18% per participant. The fee covers tuition, board and lodging, courseware (in electronic form) and other facilities of the College including internet usage.

Non-Residential Fee: Rs. 33,000/- plus GST as applicable, presently 18% per participant. The fee covers tuition, course ware (in electronic form) working lunch and other facilities of the College including internet usage.

A discount of 10% on the Programme fee for three or more participants from the same organisation will be given, provided the payment is credited into our Bank account before **April 13, 2020**.
